City of London Sinfonia (CLS) is an orchestra rooted in the belief that music and creativity are for anyone and everyone.

Our CLS Patrons share our love of music and are a close-knit group of music lovers committed to helping our dynamic group of musicians to take music to where communities already gather.

Your support will help us grow our spirit of innovation, creativity and inclusivity to ensure everyone knows classical music is something they can experience and enjoy in their own way.

As an independent charity, we do not receive regular public funding and rely on the generosity of individuals, companies, and other funders to sustain our Orchestra.

£250 could enable a Workshop Leader to plan a term of creative music-making sessions to ignite an early years child's development skills in readiness for school and increase their love of music.
